# Components

## 1. Choose your property investment\*

Rent a property for a minimum of €12,000 per annum in Malta, or €10,000 in the South of Malta or Gozo.

Purchase a property for a minimum of €350,000 in Malta, or €300,000 in the South of Malta or Gozo.

*\*To be held for a minimum of 5 years, after which a residential property is required.*

## 2. Direct contribution to the Government of Malta

If you choose to rent a property, a direct contribution of €58,000 is required.

If you choose to purchase a property, a direct contribution of €28,000 is required.

The direct contribution has to be settled within 8 months following the issuance of a Letter of Approval in Principle and can be paid in tranches.

## 3. Non-refundable administration fee

A non-refundable administration fee of €40,000 applies, out of which an initial fee of €10,000 to be settled within one month of submission of application, and the rest amounting to €30,000 to be settled within 2 months following the issuance of a Letter of Approval in Principle.

## 4. Health Insurance for Malta

A health insurance covering risks in Malta only, for main applicant and all dependants.



## 5. Donation to a Voluntary Organisation

A donation of €2,000 applies, to a local registered philanthropic, cultural, sport, scientific, animal welfare or artistic non-governmental organisation or society registered with the Commissioner for Voluntary Organisations, or as otherwise approved by the Agency.

## 6. Fees & Contributions

<b>Main Applicant</b>	<b>Option 1</b> (purchase a property): €40,000 - Administration fee & €28,000 - Government contribution  <b>Option 2</b> (lease a property): €40,000 - Administration fee & €58,000 - Government contribution
<b>Parents/Grandparents</b>	<b>€7,500</b>
<b>Spouse of an already approved main applicant</b>	<b>€7,500</b>
<b>Spouse of an already approved dependent child</b>	<b>€7,500</b>
<b>Child 18+ principally dependent on main applicant after approval</b>	<b>€5,000</b>
<b>Minor child, of an already approved dependent child and/or of his already approved spouse</b>	<b>€5,000</b>
